

PRIVACY POLICY

OnPoint, a wholly owned subsidiary of Sapient Corporation ("OnPoint" or "we"), is committed to protecting the privacy of the personally identifiable information that we collect from you as you use this Web site (the "Site"). The scope of OnPoint's commitment is detailed in this Privacy Policy. By submitting information, you agree to OnPoint's use of such information as described herein. Please see our Terms of Use for more information about our online policies in general.

What personally identifiable information is collected?

OnPoint collects personally identifiable information ("Personal Information") on certain areas of the Site when users register, request information or a response, sign up for events, apply for jobs, and participate in user posting areas, such as bulletin boards, discussion forums, and surveys. The personal information collected may include, without limitation, your access ID/password, company or school affiliations, and contact information (names, mailing and e-mail addresses, phone/fax numbers).

How may my Personal Information be used?

OnPoint uses your Personal Information to fulfill your requests for information, to process your requests to participate in events, and to review and consider any employment-related inquiries that you may submit. We may keep any of your Personal Information on file and use it to contact you for recruiting purposes. OnPoint may also use Personal Information in analyzing Site user behavior in order to measure interest in specific items posted on our Site. The e-mail addresses provided at registration allow OnPoint to send e-mails to individuals based on the areas of interest that they indicate during the registration process. If you do not wish to receive e-mailed advance notice of items posted on the Site, simply do not check off any of the subject boxes on the registration page. OnPoint uses Personal Information collected from cookies and IP addresses as described below. OnPoint may provide your Personal Information to any of its affiliates worldwide for such purposes.

Are cookies and IP addresses used?

The Site uses cookies to identify you and your interests and to track usage of the Site. Cookies are small pieces of text stored on your computer that help us know which browser you are using, where you have been on the Site, and on Web sites to which you may link in order to use some of our features. Cookies also let us know whether you have registered



with us and otherwise enable us to relate your current usage of the Site to prior usage of this or other Sites of OnPoint or its affiliates. By accepting our cookies, you will be permitted access to certain pages of the Site without having to log in each time you visit. A user who does not accept the cookies from the Site may not be able to access certain areas of the Site. OnPoint also logs IP addresses, or the location of computers on the Internet, to help diagnose problems with our server and to administer the Site.

Is Personal Information disclosed to third parties?

OnPoint will not intentionally disclose (and will take commercially reasonable steps to prevent the accidental disclosure of) your Personal Information to third parties (i.e., persons or entities that are not affiliates of OnPoint), whether for such third parties' marketing purposes or otherwise, subject only to the following four exceptions:

- 1. OnPoint may disclose your Personal Information to third parties as required or permitted by the laws, rules, and regulations of any nation, state, or other applicable jurisdiction.
- 2. OnPoint may disclose your Personal Information to third parties who deliver information from us to you for the purpose of performing such delivery.
- 3. OnPoint may disclose your Personal Information if, in connection with submitting the information, you consent to such disclosure.
- 4. OnPoint may disclose contact information for you in response to inquiries by bona-fide rights owners in connection with allegations of infringement of copyright or other proprietary rights arising from information you have posted on the Site or otherwise provided to OnPoint.
- 5. If OnPoint and/or any of its affiliates merges with or sells substantially all of its assets or a majority of its equity to a third party, information collected by OnPoint or such affiliates on their Web sites may be disclosed to and owned by the merged entity or third party.

Links to third-party sites

We may provide links to third-party Web sites as a service to our users. In addition, some of the content appearing to be on this Site is in fact supplied by third parties, for example, in instances of framing of third-party Web sites or incorporation through framesets of content supplied by third-party servers. We cannot control and are not responsible for the information collection and privacy practices of such third-party Web sites, which may differ from those of this Site.

How can I access, change, and/or delete information?



You may access, correct, update, and/or delete any Personal Information that you submitted to the Site. You may also unsubscribe from mailing lists or any registrations on the Site. Security

OnPoint has implemented generally accepted standards of technology and operational security to protect Personal Information from loss, misuse, alteration, or destruction. Only authorized OnPoint personnel are provided access to Personal Information, and these employees are required to treat this information as confidential. Despite these precautions, OnPoint cannot guarantee that unauthorized persons will not obtain access to your Personal Information.

Children's online privacy protection

OnPoint understands the importance of protecting children's privacy, especially in an online environment. The Site is not intentionally designed for or directed at children 13 years of age or younger, and OnPoint will not intentionally collect or maintain information about anyone under the age of 13.
